

# **Highlights of the Columbia and Snake Rivers**

Multnomah Falls is the most visited natural recreation site in the Pacific Northwest with more than two million visitors taking in the views each year. Underground springs feed the waterfall from Larch Mountain. The flow over the falls is usually highest during the winter and spring seasons. The waterfall is accessible from the Historic Columbia River Highway and Interstate 84. Spanning two tiers on basalt cliffs, it is the tallest waterfall in the state of Oregon at 620 ft (189 m) in height. The Multnomah Creek Bridge was built in 1914 and crosses below the falls. The bridge is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

## **Featuring Unique Horse Farm**

March 18 - 21, 2024

**DAY 1 Travel to Cincinnati, OH:** This morning we will make our way to near Cincinnati, OH where we'll stay in a hotel close to the Creation Museum. Along the way we will stop to have a relaxing lunch.

DAY 2 Creation Museum: After breakfast at the hotel, we will drive to the Creation Museum to experience state-of-the-art exhibits and see the history of the Bible vividly come to life at this world-class museum. On your walk through biblical history, you'll encounter a realistic Garden of Eden, animatronic Noah, Flood dioramas, stunning video displays, a 4-D special-effects theater, and much more. During your visit to the museum you'll be able to have lunch at Noah's Café. After our visit we have a 45 minute drive to our next hotel.

DAY 3 Ark Encounter: After breakfast we have a short drive to the Ark. The full-sized replica of Noah's Ark is a massive wooden structure: the largest wooden timber structure IN THE WORLD! It measures 510 feet long and more than 50 feet tall! Compare that to a football field that measures 360 feet endzone to endzone. This self-paced tour does require a lot of walking, but there are benches







# Featuring Timberline Lodge, Hells Canyon, and the Coeur d'Alene Casino Resort Hotel

September 8 - 15, 2024

### **DAY 1** Arrive in Oregon: Welcome to Portland.

Our touring begins with a ferry ride around New York Harbor that will tour by the Statue of Liberty, where we will view France's gift of International Friendship to the US. Located on Liberty Island in New York Harbor, the Statue of Liberty is one of the most universal symbols of political freedom and democracy. Here we will get a wonderful up close and personal view of the Lady as she stands in New York Harbor, since 1886. The cruise will continue and go by Ellis Island where over 100 million can trace their immigrant roots. Between 1892 and 1954, 12 million immigrants entered the United States through this door and began their journey in this brave new world.

After arriving back in Manhattan your guide will show you the downtown area including "Ground Zero" and a guided tour of the 9/11 memorial the site of the former World Trade Center. At this 16-acre site, we reflect on this tragic time in our history, which has affected us all and see the magnificence of the new One World Trade Center. We will take an elevator to New York's tallest observation deck and get 360 degree views of all of New York City from the One World Observatory atop the One World Trade Center. ### **Horizons Club Trips Terms & Conditions**

Horizons Club trips (one-day trips and extended trips) are planned as an added service to our club members and as a benefit of club membership. First State Community Bank (FSCB) makes every reasonable effort to ensure that trips are logically planned and that they provide entertainment and/or educational value. We do not expect any major changes from the published itinerary. However, in the spirit of adventure, we allow our itinerary to remain flexible so that we may take advantage of spontaneous events.

Payment is due upon reservation. A cancellation deadline is listed on the itinerary for the amount of time necessary to confirm plans with suppliers. There are occasions when FSCB may accept late reservations and payments for trips, if space allows and if the supplier(s) accept(s) additional reservations. Late reservations and payments will be accepted from people on the waiting list first, and then from newer requests after the waiting list has been exhausted.

Cancellations made after the cancellation deadline are <u>not</u> <u>entitled to a refund</u>. However, when a person cancels a reservation after the deadline if the seat can be filled by a member from a wait list, then a refund will be paid to the original person minus a substitution service fee. (Additional fees may be charged for substitutions after the cancellation deadline based on fees due to suppliers for alterations made to the confirmed reservations.)
