DAY 1: Niagara Falls

Arrive in Toronto, followed by a greeting from a professional tour guide and motorcoach. Transfer to a hotel in Niagara Falls, Ontario, the home base for the next four nights. **Meal: D**

DAY 2: Niagara Falls

A full-day tour of the Niagara Falls area, featuring Horseshoe Falls, Queen Victoria Park, and Table Rock Centre. A special highlight includes an immersive viewing of Niagara's Fury, offering a dramatic introduction to the natural power of the Falls. In the afternoon, enjoy a thrilling Hornblower Cruise for an up-close encounter with the cascading water as millions of gallons plunge 289 feet to the rocks below. The cruise provides sweeping views of the Falls, mist-filled air, churning waters, and the iconic thunderous roar. (If weather conditions prevent cruising, the itinerary will shift to the Journey Behind the Falls tunnels for an equally impressive perspective.) Dinner will be served at a restaurant overlooking the illuminated Falls, followed by free time to explore the area independently. Options include viewing the nighttime illumination or visiting the lively Clifton Hill entertainment district. **Meals: B, D**

DAY 3: Niagara Falls

The day begins with a visit to the renowned Niagara Parks Botanical Gardens and Butterfly Conservatory, located just north of Niagara Falls along the Niagara River as it flows toward Lake Ontario. Established in 1936, the Botanical Gardens span 99 acres of meticulously maintained landscapes featuring perennials, rhododendrons, azaleas, a formal parterre garden, herb and vegetable plantings, and a world-famous rose garden with more than 2,400 roses. The Butterfly Conservatory offers one of North America's largest glass-enclosed tropical environments. Wander through nearly 200 yards of winding pathways surrounded by lush vegetation, gentle waterfalls, and more than 2,000 vibrantly colored butterflies in free flight. The itinerary continues with a stop at the iconic Floral Clock, designed with up to 16,000 carpet bedding plants arranged in intricate patterns that change twice annually. Travel to and from Niagara Falls also includes views of the dramatic Niagara Whirlpool and its Class 6 rapids. Dinner this evening is at leisure in Niagara Falls. **Meal: B**

DAY 4: Niagara-on-the-Lake

Travel 15 miles to Niagara-on-the-Lake, often regarded as Canada's prettiest town and home to the celebrated Shaw Festival. This charming village offers a peaceful escape with historic architecture, tree-lined streets, and boutique shops along Queen Street. Explore the Old Town District, browse local shops, and visit Fort George, a British stronghold constructed to defend against American forces during the War of 1812. Lunch is at leisure. In the afternoon, visit one of the region's premier wineries. The Niagara wine region is known for exceptional vintages and is the birthplace of ice wine, a celebrated sweet dessert wine. Return to Niagara Falls for an evening visit to the Skylon Tower, the city's most recognizable landmark. On clear days, the observation deck offers views spanning nearly 8,000 square miles across both Canada and the United States, including the skylines of Toronto and Buffalo. Dinner will be enjoyed at the Skylon Tower before retiring for the night. **Meals: B, D**

DAY 5: Niagara Falls - Tour Ends

Enjoy breakfast before departing for the airport. **Meal: B**
