DAY 1: Washington, DC Arrive in Washington, DC and transfer to area accommodations. After a welcome dinner, we will be treated to an illumination tour of the city. We will see many of the capital's famous monuments highlighted with spotlights that accentuate their beauty. **Meal: D**

DAY 2: Washington, DC A day of exploration awaits in our nation's capital! See the White House, the Capitol Building, the Washington Monument, the Lincoln Monument, and the Jefferson Memorial. Pause at the Korean, Vietnam, and World War II War Memorials. The afternoon will be dedicated to the exploration of the Smithsonian, made up of a large variety of separate museums. Dinner is included this evening. **Meals: B, D**

DAY 3: Washington, DC Area Today, tour Mount Vernon, the plantation of George Washington built in 1734 by his father. Tour the grounds including the gardens and the tomb of George and Martha Washington. Enjoy lunch in the 18th century Mount Vernon Inn Restaurant. This afternoon, we'll travel to Arlington National Cemetery with graves of more than 250,000 U.S. soldiers. Visit the Maine Memorial, the Kennedy Gravesites and the Tomb of the Unknowns with the Changing of the Guard. Dinner is on your own this evening. **Meals: B, L**

DAY 4: Richmond, VA Today, we depart Washington, DC, for a four-night stay in Virginia Beach. On the way, we'll stop in Richmond for lunch in the charming Carytown District before experiencing a re-enactment of Patrick Henry's historic "Give me Liberty or Give me Death" speech at St. John's Church. After settling into our hotel, we'll cap off the evening with a wine tasting and special dinner at the renowned Mermaid Winery. Then, it's a short drive back to the hotel to relax and unwind. **Meals: B, D**

DAY 5: Norfolk, VA We'll spend the day in Norfolk, starting with tours of Nauticus, a maritime science center, and the Battleship Wisconsin. Then, we'll enjoy reserved seating for the Parade of Nations, where **Virginia International Tattoo** performers march through the streets. Afterward, we'll cruise the Naval Base for a narrated view of massive ships. A stop at Doumars, home of the original waffle cone, will provide a sweet treat. This afternoon, we'll visit The MacArthur Memorial before an early dinner. The highlight of the evening is the **Virginia International Tattoo**, a stunning display of military music, pipes and drums, drill maneuvers, and elegant dance. **Meals: B, D**

DAY 6: Outer Banks, NC After breakfast, we'll travel from Virginia Beach to the Outer Banks, home to America's First Beach and the site of the Lost Colony. Our first stop is the Wright Brothers National Memorial, where we'll hear a ranger's talk, see flight markers, and explore the monument. In the afternoon, we'll visit Corolla for a safari-style tour to see wild horses roaming the dunes. After dinner, we'll return to Virginia Beach. **Meals: B, D**

DAY 7: Virginia Beach, VA We'll start today with a relaxed breakfast before touring Virginia Beach. Our morning stop is The Military Aviation Museum, home to one of the largest private collections of restored WWI and WWII aircrafts. The afternoon is free to unwind, explore, swim, or stroll the boardwalk. Tonight, we'll enjoy a final group dinner before settling in for the night. **Meals: B, D**

DAY 8: Virginia Beach, VA - Tour Ends What a week it has been—who knew there was so much to experience right by the Atlantic in one of America's favorite coastal destinations! **Meal: B**
