DAY 5: Sedona at Leisure Sedona, an artist community, is set amongst the red-hued rocks of Oak Creek Canyon. Its breathtaking beauty fills the senses and soothes the soul. Today has been reserved as a day of leisure. Once virtually a ghost town, it is now restored with shops, museums, and art. Later, climb aboard the Verde Canyon Railroad for a spectacular journey over old-fashioned trestles, past ancient Indian ruins, and through a 700-foot tunnel. Enjoy the views from your first-class seat or from one of the open-air viewing cars. Admire the wildflowers, blooming cacti, and diverse wildlife in their natural habitat. Tonight, chow down with a chuckwagon supper at the "Blazin' M Ranch" and Western Stage Show. Meal: B, D

DAY 7: Phoenix - Tour Ends As your Arizona adventure concludes, take home unforgettable memories of the stunning landscapes and vibrant culture. The group will transfer to Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport for afternoon flights. **Meal: B**
